Dear Professors:

I am writing to confirm details of agreements we reached concerning your possible appointments here.

First, on the library, the campus will support the development of acquisition in support of East Asian languages and literature with an initial annual budget of \$100,000 for materials. Funding in subsequent years is expected to increase. Staffing will begin with a Chinese language bibliographer and such additional support as is necessary to assure the processing of materials so that they are accessible in a timely manner to faculty and students. A Japanese language bibliographer and cataloguing support (as needed) will be added in the future. A CJK terminal will be installed to give UCI more effective access to other collections through interlibrary loan, and arrangements will be initiated to secure twenty-four hour "turnaround" service from UCLA's East Asian Collection.

I hope this addresses your major issues, and that you will be joining us at UCI in building what I fully expect will be a strong and important campus program.
