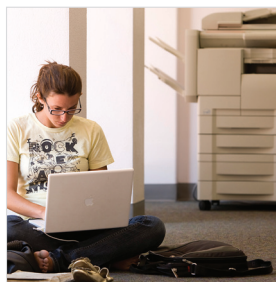

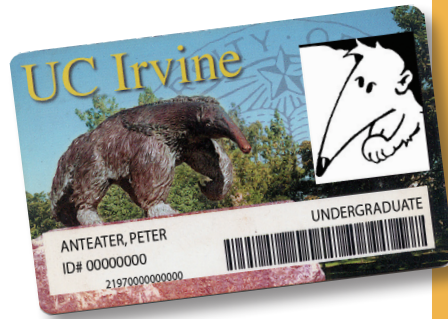

## GETTING A LIBRARY CARD

- UCI PhotoIDs are used as library cards for current students, faculty, and staff. Activate your card in person at any of the loan desks.
- A valid library card is required to check out material.
- Library cards are for personal use only and may not be loaned or transferred.



## LOAN PERIODS

Loan periods vary between libraries and are based on user category and type of material. Be sure to return or renew your checked out items promptly.

## RENEWALS

You can renew items by accessing your library account in My ANTPAC. Materials can also be renewed by phone or in person at our loan desks.

## RECALLS AND HOLDS

Requests for recalls or holds on checked out items can be placed through My ANTPAC or at any loan desk. If a recall is placed on an item that you have checked out, a recall notice will be sent listing the new due date. To avoid fines, return items with holds or recalls before the due date.
