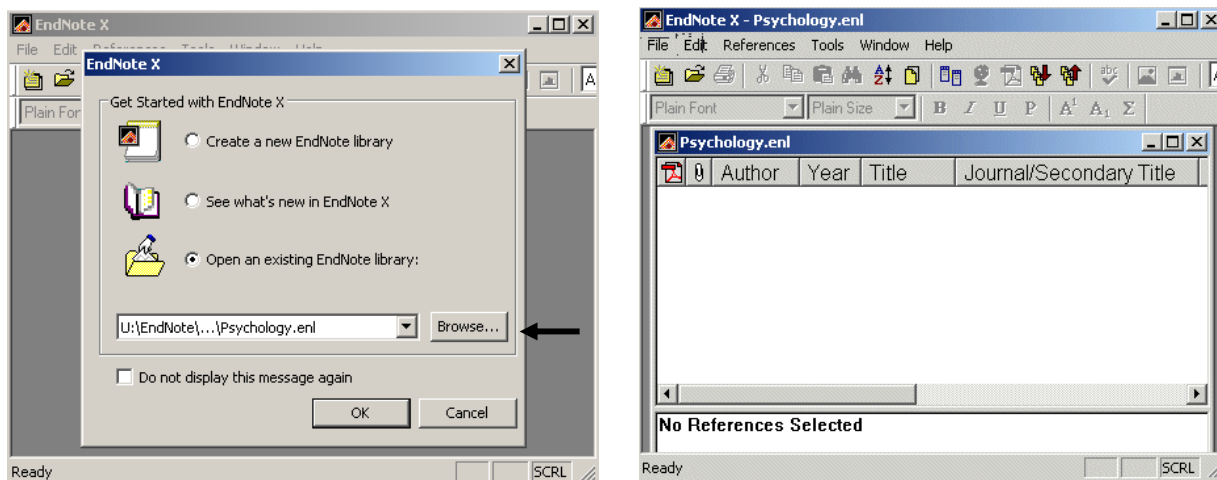


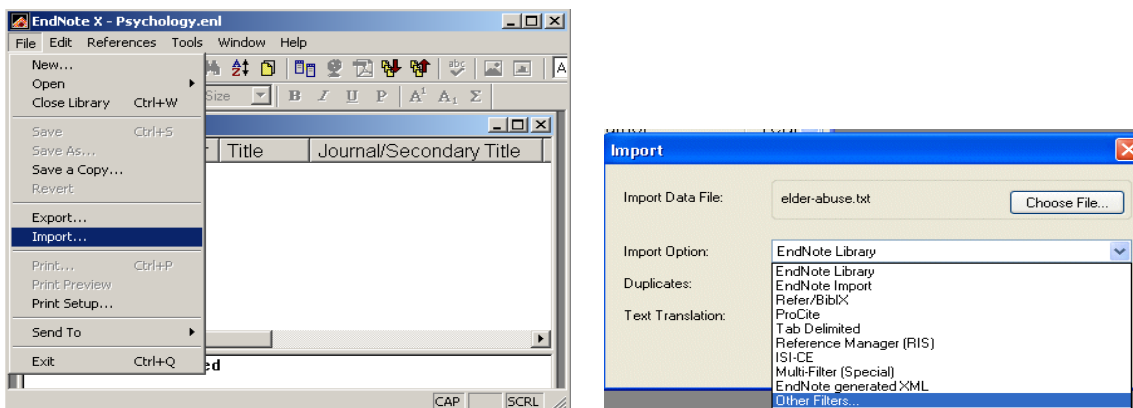
UCI Libraries EndNote X User Guide

Importing PubMed Citations to the Newly Created Endnote Library Database

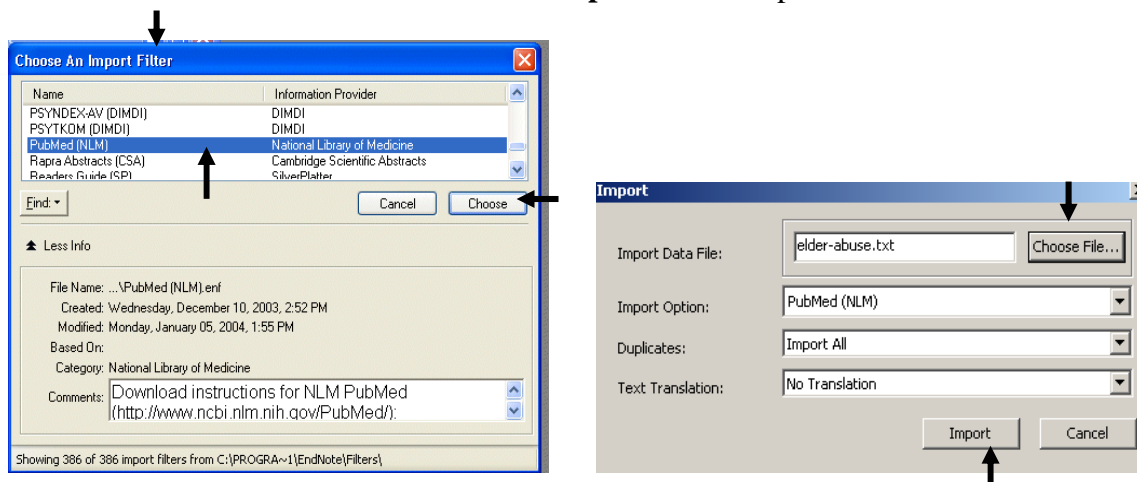
1. Double click on the EndNote icon located on your desktop to bring up the **Get Started with EndNote X** window, click the **Browse** pull-down button to find the EndNote Library that you created earlier, e.g. **psychology**. Select the file and click the **OK** button to proceed. This will bring up the empty, “**Psychology.enl**” library as figure shown below.



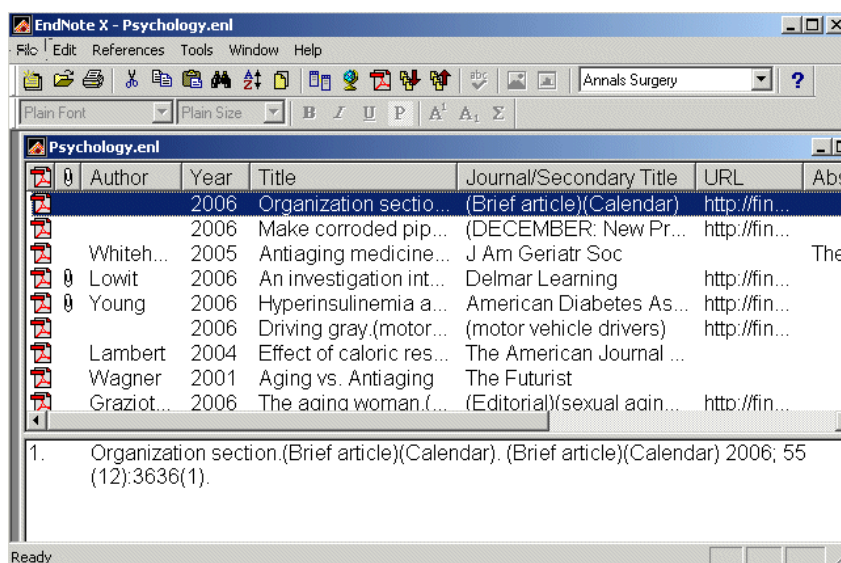
2. At the EndNote **File** pull-down menu, select “**Import...**” This will bring up the **Import** window. Click the **Choose File...** button once to locate the saved PubMed file, “**elder-abuse.txt**”. Double click on the file when you find it. The “**elder-abuse.txt**” file appears in the **Import Data File:** window. Click the **Import Option** pull-down menu and select **Other Filters...**



- The "Choose An Import Filter" window appears on the screen. Scroll down to locate and select **PubMed [NLM]**. Once the filter is found, click the "Choose" button to proceed. This step will take you back to the **Import** window. Leave "Duplicates: Import All" and "Text Translation: No Translation" as the default. Click the **Import** button to proceed.



- All the references from the **.txt** file will be transferred into the EndNote Library **psychology** library. See figure below.



Now you have successfully imported all the NLM PubMed citations to the EndNote Library. Congratulations!!
